### Professors and Lessons

Learn German quickly, effectively and successfully: this is the goal that ASL has made most important in studying. Highly specialized professors in teaching German as a foreign language design varied exciting lessons that aim for success.

### Small Studygroups

Before the beginning of the course, an applicant will be asked to write an exam that classifies the applicant's german language ability. The participants of the group courses will be put in the internationally attended coursegroups, which have between 8-16 participants. In the courses "Courses for Scholars and University Students" and "Singular and Small Group Courses", the participant's individual performance aims are understandably taken into consideration and agreed upon.

### Advanced Systems of Languages

This means that through using the highly developed „Direct method“ of teaching, the instructor and student only speak german from the start of the first course. The learning program that is used is clearly structured, the structure of vocabulary and grammar are logically built on one another.

### Lesson Materials

Modern, specialized and optimally processed study materials support the learning success of the participant. After the end of every Course, the participant receives confirmation of attending the course and after writing the final exam each participant receives a pass Certificate.

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## German at ASL

Foreigners can learn German quickly and thoroughly through the German language courses provided by ASL. ASL has had many years of experience in teaching foreign students. Central to ASL is an internationally warm atmosphere, whereby qualified and experienced teachers provide a high quality of lessons for the student. In the last 20 years ASL has made concentration on the needs of the applicant and affordable fees the main aspects of learning German in München.

## The Course System

Applicants may choose from the following courses provided at ASL:

### Intensive Courses

The Intensive Courses portray the main emphasis of courses at ASL. They are suitable for all participants who at a fair price and in the shortest amount of time want to learn or improve their German. The five hour long daily lessons lead to fast improvement and optimal success: fluent and correct use of the German language is the result thereof.

ASL offers year-round Intensive Courses from beginners level to Oberstufe. Many participants learn German at ASL from Grundstufe I up to DHS, many of them Au-Pairs. Other participants have already learnt German in their home countries and want to improve their knowledge of the language.

## Exam Preparation Courses

In the exam preparation Courses the participant will be prepared and helped by professors qualified with the DaF certificate, for specific exams that are necessary for a foreigner to be accepted for entrance for further study in Germany. Within eight weeks the participant will reach a calibre in German language where they will be able to pass the entrance exam for further study.

In addition to this, ASL also offers preparation courses for different generally recognised German language exams, with which the candidate can prove qualification in spoken and written German worldwide.

ASL prepares the candidate for the following exams:

### Holiday Courses

Holiday courses combine the visitor's stay in München with learning and improving the German language. The

practical use of German in meeting others and living with the host family is an important element of the Course. Holiday Courses also specify in the improvement of German for School and University use.

### Courses for Schools and Universities

For the last 20 years ASL has carried out programs for Scholars and University students, specifically those from Europe. For example: Scholars from Italian and French Highschools, College students from the USA or University students from Japan together with their teachers and professors are regular and impressed guests at our School.

The program is co-ordinated to fit the wishes of the participants and their lecturers during their stay. Through a friendly atmosphere, qualified teachers carry out language instruction and verbally accompany the Students through their pre-organised cultural and leisure activities.

### Singular and Small group Courses

Singular courses are the fastest and most effective way to learn German. They are planned for the participant to reach a certain language goal in a specific time limit. Through this way of teaching, the participant personally chooses the course time, length per lesson, frequency of lessons as well as how intense the lessons are.

Courses for small groups are ideal for interested participants who, due to limited time or job related reasons cannot attend the Intensive courses and who want to improve their German knowledge quickly and well. Therefore many International Companies whose employees, despite limited study time, achieve the necessary language requirements that their work requires. Course prices and times are shared between employees.

### The guest families of ASL

ASL puts a lot of worth in the selection of host families. All families are open-minded and try very hard to make the Student's stay in München as comfortable as possible. ASL will also naturally try to find residence in a Bed & Breakfast or Hotel in the München area or close to the School if it is preferred.

## Visa for university students or applicants

(not necessary for EU-citizens)

1. In order to get a visa for university applicants (more than 3 months up to 18 months) it is necessary to have your school and university certificates acknowledged by a German authority that checks if you can study at a German university.

Transfer the course fee for at least 8 weeks (720 Euro) to the bank account of ASL. For some countries payment for 3 months (1080 Euro) is required, e.g. China, Mongolia, Vietnam etc. You can also pay online, please visit our website [www.aslsprachen.de](http://www.aslsprachen.de) and go to enrolment.

ASL will send you a letter of acceptance and invitation which is necessary for the German embassy or consulate in your home country.

In case of visa rejection or are important circumstances we can make a refund of your payment if you send us an official notice of rejection or return our original letter of invitation. Cancellation fee is EUR 60.
